Memorandum of Association of

'PUNARVAS KALYAN SAMITTI (DELHI PRADESH).'

1. Name of the society : the name of the society shall be

'Punarvas Kalyan Samitti (Delhi

~~Praadesh~~)'

2. The registered office of the society shall be situated in the Union Territory of Delhi, at present it is at;

H.No.219, Vill.

Begampur, Delhi-42.

3. Aims and objects:-

The aims and objects for which the society shall be established is as under:-

i) To create a sense of brotherhood, cooperation, love and affection amongst the people of different religions and castes;

ii) To cater for the needs of 'Punarvas Colony's Residents', in the Union Territory of Delhi, and to help them in distress by taking up the matter with the authorities concerned.

iii) To arrange seminars, lectures, pucca road, electric and water supply and discussion of all matters of public interest except politics;

iv) To provide the education to uneducated adults and helpless children of the area;

v) To propagate the general public about the untouchability amongst man and to take up effective steps regarding the untouchability;

vi) To help the poor and needy person(s) in the occasions of their marriage(s), festival(s), illness etc. and to raise up the effective steps during the period of war or flood time to prevent the human being.

vii) To take the necessary action against Dahej Pratha & Bal Vivah, and to save the concerned person(s) from the above starvation;

viii) Income of the society shall be utilised only for attainment of above objects.



- viii) To engage in social service activities for improving the living conditions and the general economic conditions of the poor;
- ix) To distribute the free food, clothings etc. for the poor and needy persons;
- x) To provide medical aid and medical facilities to suffering persons and to aid, to promote, to open hospitals, dispensaries, operation theaters, clinics and or to provide medicine free or at cost.
- xi) To establish or open the instruction centres of all over India and abroad for imparting instruction in all languages in theory and practice of 'Yoga Science' which include the imparting of instructions in the theory and practice of Yogic Shadhan Shat-Karma, Yogic Sukshma Vigyan Yogic, Pranayam etc. for the retention and enhancement of physical, mental and spiritual energy cure of diseases, cure of mental and physical weakness, cure of obesity and their physical deformities of bodies;
- xii) To open the Schools, Training Centres in the Union Territory of Delhi, and to manage its affairs from time to time;
- xiii) To establish play grounds, Vyamshales and to provide them necessary facilities etc. for the improvement of the health of the children & the public;
- xiv) To arrange and organise the Religious, Educational and cultural programmes from time to time;
- xv) All the income of the society shall be utilized for the promotion of aims and objects of the society contd..



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## RULES AND REGULATION OF

'Punarvas Kalvan Samitti (Rajhi Pradesh)'

1. Membership:-

The membership of the society is open to any person or persons who has attained the age of majority and fulfils the terms and conditions of the society, without discrimination of religion, caste, colour and creed but subject to the approval of the governing body if the membership is refused to a certain ~~many~~ person or persons, the reason for refusal shall be communicated to the person concerned.

2. Subscription:-

Admission fee Rs. 21/- at the time of admission  
Subscription Rs. 05/- per month.

3. Termination of Membership:-

The governing body shall have the power to expel a member from the society on the following terms and conditions:-

- a) On his/her death.
- b) Non payment of subscription continuously for more than three months from due date.
- c) On his/her written resignation.
- d) If he/she has not attended three consecutive meetings of the general body without any intimation.

4. Appeals:-

All the appeals should be preferred to the governing body of the society, the decision of the governing body shall be final. The reason for rejection shall be communicated to the person concerned.

5. Re-admissions:-

In case of member expelled by the governing body, the same can be re-admitted provided the member concerned pays all upto date dues. The decision of the governing body shall be final.

6. Governing Body:-

The governing body shall consist of all members and office bearers as under:-

1. President.....one
2. Vice-president.....one
3. Gen.Secretary.....one
4. Secretary.....one
5. Treasurer.....one
6. Members from...4.....to...8.....

7. Bank Account:-

The Bank Account of the society shall be operated by the Treasurer and General Secretary

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8. Functions of General Body:-

- a) To consider any business brought forward by the governing body.
- b) There shall be an annual meeting of the general body in the month of March every year.
- c) Not less than 5 days notice shall be given to the members before the date of general body meeting enclosing the agenda specifying date, time and place.

9. Sources of income:-

- i) Admission fee.
- ii) Subscription.
- iii) Donation and special contributions.

10. Governing Body:-

The governing body's strength shall not be less than 7 and not more than 17. The members of the governing body shall hold the office for two years. The meeting of the governing body shall be held as and when necessary for which 15 days clear notice will be required and the quorum shall be 2/3rd.

11. Election and Quorum:-

The general body in its annual meeting will elect its President and all the office bearers and members in the month of March after two years by secret ballot papers. The quorum of the general body and governing body shall be 2/3rd .



12.

Functions of the governing body:-

- a) To arrange, finance if required from other Bank(s), institution or individuals on reasonable terms and conditions and the governing body as a whole is liable for its return.
- b) The governing body shall make plan for the future programmes of the society.
- c) To appoint, terminate and fix duties of any staff.
- d) The governing body shall meet atleast once in a month.
- e) To publish literature, to propagate the system and to approach the public for the uplift the status of the society.
- f) To accept donations, charities, loans, grants properties, etc. from public, other associations, agencies. Govt. Deptt. in the interest of the promotion of the aims and objects of the society.

13.

Management of Funds:-

All the income of the society shall be deposited in the Bank.

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14. Powers and Duties of the Office Bearers:-

President:-

He will be the head of the society and preside over the meeting of the general body and governing body. He will have the right of casting of vote in case of tie.

Vice-president:-

In the absence of the President the Vice-president shall enjoy all powers which are entrusted to the President.

General Secretary:-

The powers and duties of general secretary shall be as under:-

- a) To sign on behalf of the society and to conduct its correspondence and to record the proceedings of such meeting.
- b) To summon and attend the meeting of the general body.
- c) To call ordinary general meeting if desired on written request of atleast twenty members.

Secretary:-

In the absence of the general secretary the secretary shall enjoy all powers which are entrusted to the general secretary .

Treasurer:-

He will account of all receipts and expenditures of the society and to furnish necessary information to the governing body. He will keep with him Rs. 500/- and the balance amount will have to be deposited in the Bank/Post Office etc.



15. Audits:-

The accounts of the society shall be audited atleast once a year by an auditor appointed by the governing body

16. Financial year:-

The financial year of the society shall start from the 1st day of April to 31st day of March every year.

17. Tenure:-

The terms of governing body shall be two years.

18. Amendment:-

(Alteration, extension or abridgment) of purposes' (Aims and objects) or change of name, section 12 and 12-A of the S.R. Act of 1860 as applicable to the Union Territory of Delhi. The amendment in the memorandum shall be made under this section.

19. Legal proceedings (section 6 of the Act)

The society may sue or be sued in the name of the President as per provisions laid down under section S.R. Act, 1860 as applicable to the Union Territory of Delhi

20. Annual list of governing body:-

Once in every year a list of the office bearers and members of the governing body shall be filed with the registrar of society Delhi as required under section 4 of the societies regn. Act of 1860 as applicable to the Union Territory of Delhi.

21. Dissolution:-






Application of the Act:-
